IMPACT ASSESSMENT?

Impact assessment (IA) is a transformative process designed to inform and guide decisions and actions by government, businesses, or individuals. It aims to maximize positive outcomes while minimizing negative effects, ultimately supporting sustainable development.



A FEW TYPES OF

IMPACT ASSESSMENT

- **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA):** A project's impact on the physical environment: air, water, soil, biodiversity, etc.
- Social Impact Assessment (SIA): Effects on people and communities: displacement, livelihoods, culture, etc.
- Health Impact Assessment (HIA): Impacts on public health, including mental health, access to health services, etc.
- Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA): For policies and planning, assesses broader, long-term impacts for decision-making strategy.
- Cumulative Effects Assessment (CEA): Combined, incremental effects of multiple activities over time and space on the environment or society.
- Human Rights Impact Assessment (HRIA): Evaluates if a project or policy respects, protects, and promotes international human rights.

Supports compliance with laws and policies








GLOBAL RELEVANCE

OF IMPACT ASSESSMENT


- Required in 190+ countries


