### **OPENING RECEPTION**

#### \$24,000 | 1 Available

Support for professionals from developing countries or countries in transition, and support for student participants: At approximately \$4,500 per person, your organization could provide application criteria and the number of persons to sponsor, and IAIA will work with you in selecting delegates and handle all the processing and logistical arrangements. The sponsorship covers registration fees, special activities, airfare, hotel, and daily expenses. The amount will vary depending on the home country of each of the participants. Because of the time needed to make travel and visa arrangements and to confirm the delegates' places on the program, this sponsorship must be confirmed by 15 July 2008.
