Who can view the group content?

Posts to the IAIA Members group and Committee groups can only be viewed by members of each group. However, in the interest of sharing information, posts to Section groups can be viewed by anybody, whether IAIA members or not. Non-members can browse Section group content from the login page (iaiaconnect.iaia.org) by clicking the "Groups" link in the right column, but they can only post content to the site if they are an IAIA member.

Login bypass

When you receive an e-mail digest showing new discussions, announcements, or resources added to your groups, click any link in the email to go directly to IAIAConnect and bypass the login process. You can determine if you want a daily or weekly digest, or none at all. Note that for security purposes, this login bypass works once per session. After you have logged out of IAIAConnect or shut down your computer, the link from that specific digest will require a login.

My Home

Member Matching: By answering these questions, you'll find out who else within IAIA best "matches" you on the same items. Another great way to connect!

My Events: Lists events from the groups to which you belong.

Message Center: Send and receive messages to and from other IAIA members within IAIA Connect.

Resources: Shows the resources you have personally added to the site.

My Contacts: This is like your personal address book for IAIA members. You can search the "Members" directory and click "Add as contact" (far right icon after each name). IAIA Connect will send that person a message, and once they approve, the person will appear in your "My Contacts" list.

My Content Alerts: Select from a variety of alert topics that interest you. Anytime those topics appear in public IAIA Connect groups, even if you haven't joined that group, you'll be notified on your IAIA Connect Home page.

My Feeds: There are many news sources on the web that send daily or weekly news digests. You can subscribe to one IAIA has pre-selected, or you can add your own. (If you have a news feed or RSS link you think other IAIA members would appreciate, please contact bridget@iaia.org, and we can add it to the list for others to select as well.)

My Groups: Groups you have personally joined.

My Saved Items: Anytime you click an icon with a yellow star, that resource, group, member or event will be saved in My Saved Items.

General

Members: This is a searchable directory of all IAIA members.

Resources: All public IAIA resources are housed here. Note that resources uploaded to a specific group do NOT appear here (but they could be added here if you would like).

Sponsors: IAIA is currently developing how we can offer benefits to conference sponsors through this function, but there are currently no sponsors listed.

Groups: Look through all groups in this searchable group directory. Note that the group directory has the option to sort by category (Sections, Committees, etc.) as well, to make searching easier.

Events: A community calendar, showing all events.
